

## Suggested Meet Rotation Worksheet For Referees

**To assign events:** Per Rules and Policies page 34, *“When assigning judges to a competition with multiple days, assigners are encouraged to change the events each day provided the meet has a separate awards ceremony for each session.”*

Note if any judges are affiliated— he/she may only be assigned as a panel judge. Read page 35 of 2024-25 Rules and Policies for detailed information about affiliation. If the affiliated club is not attending the meet, or is not in a particular session, then that judge is not affiliated.

Normally, but not necessarily, the higher rated judge is the Chief Judge. **Start with the highest level session** and place your judges according to their strengths, experience and confidence judging a particular event. Also consider putting experienced and less experienced judges together. Once you have your judging panels for this highest level session, the numbering of the judges will stay the same. Judges will rotate to different events and with different partners. \*Note the 4<sup>th</sup> rotation sends the judges to the 4<sup>th</sup> event, but they will judge with the same partner as rotation 3.

**Judges 1, 3, 5 and 7 are Chief Judges.**

**Judges 2, 4, 6 and 8 are Panel Judges.**
